

Anuvia promotes wellness in our community by providing compassionate treatment and prevention services of the highest quality to impact the disease of addiction.




About Us




Financial Highlights

Persons Served









Prevention

The Prevention Department exceeded its goals in all measurements related to behavioral change outcomes. Constructs included anti-social/delinquent behavior, goal setting, responsible choices, parenting efficacy, and self-efficacy/decision making.

Treatment

The rate of completion, clients who successfully complete and/or are connected to more appropriate services, for all treatment programs was 58% during the fiscal year.

Letter from the Executive Director

Serving our community since 1958, Anuvia Prevention and Recovery Center fulfills our unique role in the community with a full continuum of care from primary prevention to residential treatment, with culturally competent services of the highest quality, and a focus on ease of accessibility.

In 2016/2017, Alcohol use disorders continue to be our community's greatest substance use related challenge. However, the epidemic of prescription drug and heroin abuse has advanced to a greater level necessitating more prevention and treatment focus. Also, the legalization and decriminalization of marijuana spreading across the country has contributed to a substantial decrease in the perception of risk of marijuana use, especially among youth.

This year, Anuvia contributed to improving the quality of life for over 20,000 people in our community. During this year, Anuvia initiated medication-assisted treatment and began a coalition addressing the impact of opioid use. Also, Anuvia entered its second year of managing Mecklenburg County's Detox and Residential Treatment Services at the Samuel Billings Center.

These successes would not be possible without the unwavering support of our donors, the Mecklenburg County ABC Board, Cardinal Innovations Health Solutions, and Mecklenburg County. From all of us at Anuvia, most especially our clients and our participants, we send you a heartfelt thank you for another extraordinary year in our 59 year history!
